

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

(This list contains KSAs that are typically associated with the job. It is not all-inclusive and may vary from position to position. Hiring agencies may, depending on the specific nature of the position, modify these KSAs and/or identify additional KSAs, based on a current positions analysis.)

- knowledge of turf grass and a variety of landscapes
- knowledge of different types of sprinkler and irrigation systems
- knowledge of sprinkler and irrigation control systems
- knowledge of secondary water
- knowledge of soil types and conditions within District boundaries
- knowledge of water cycle inside and outside of District boundaries
- use of electronic equipment such as smart phones, tablets and other communication devices
- use of various types of software and hardware
- speak clearly, concisely and effectively; listen to, and understand, information and ideas presented verbally
- communicate information and ideas clearly, and concisely, in writing; read and understand information presented in writing
- ability to use quick and impartial judgment based on situation at hand
- ability to thoroughly document a situation in writing
- work with or contribute to a work group or team to complete assigned task(s)
- plan, organize and prioritize time and workload in order to accomplish tasks and meet deadlines
- deal with people in a manner which shows sensitivity, tact, and professionalism
- applicable laws, rules, regulations and/or policies and procedures
- ensure compliance with policies and procedures, etc. through on-site evaluations
- make a decision or solve a problem by using logic to identify key facts, explore alternatives, and propose quality solutions
- read and interpret maps, plats, and charts
- principles and practices of GIS

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Risks found in outdoor environments and stress situations, e.g. working with persons who may be agitated or upset, working in outdoor weather conditions, etc.
- The work requires physical exertion such as walking, bending, lifting heavy objects over 50 pounds, crouching or crawling, and driving an automobile.
- Must possess a current valid driver's license and provide reliable form of transportation during performance of job.
- Graduation from high school and two (2) years of landscaping, horticultural, agricultural, code enforcement or other related experience or any equivalent combination of education and experience.
